## MEMBERS OF THE KINGDOM OF LOVE

*2 Samuel 5:1-3; Psalm 122:1-5; Colossians 1:12-20; Luke 23:35-43*

Jesus Christ, King of the Universe, is the image of the invisible God. He has rescued us from the power of darkness. He is the head of the Church which is the body of Christ. In Jesus our King we have redemption and forgiveness of sins. God the Father has transferred us into the Kingdom of Jesus Christ (*Colossians 1:12-20*).

In the Scripture we see people who have accepted the Kingship of Christ. The **three kings from the East** recognized Jesus as a king when they gave him gifts of gold, frankincense, and myrrh. (Mt 2:1-11). **The repentant thief** professed the Kingship of Jesus. “Jesus, remember me when you come into your kingdom”. Jesus, the King, even amid the agony of death, on the cross out of love and mercy responded to the repentant sinner “Truly I tell you, today you will be with me in Paradise” (Luke 23:35-43).

What kind of king is Jesus? Pilate asked him if he was a king? (Jn.18.33). He told the Roman Governor, “My kingdom is not of this world”... (Jn.18.36). It is the kingdom of truth and life; kingdom of holiness and grace; kingdom of justice, love and peace (Preface, Solemnity of Jesus Christ, King of the Universe).

The authority of Jesus is the authority of truth, love and justice. He lived the truth and can lead others to the truth - the truth that saves us to eternal life: “for this I was born and came into the world, to bear witness to the truth” (Jn.18.36-37). The whole life of Jesus was the story of the manifestation of love in its many forms such as caring and nurturing, forgiving and merciful, understanding and empathetic, comforting and consoling, responsive and reaching out.

The focus of all our sacramental celebrations and religious practices is our personal growth in close relationship with Christ. On this feast day, we declare our loyalty to Christ and His supremacy over our personal lives, our families, and the Church. We, the followers of Christ the King, and the living members of His Kingdom, are expected to observe only one major law in His Kingdom. It is the law of love. *“Love God with your whole heart and love your neighbor as yourself.” (Mt 10:10.)* On this great Feast of Christ, the King, let us resolve to give him the central place in our lives and promise to obey his commandment of love by sharing what we have with the needy who also are members of His Kingdom of love.

#### COMING OF CHRIST

We proclaim that mystery of faith at every eucharistic celebration “We proclaim your Death, O Lord, and profess your Resurrection until you come again.” Our preparations, therefore, should have all three comings in mind.
