LITURGY OF THE WORD 2025-2026

SUNDAY: YEAR A WEEKDAY - YEAR 1

First Reading: (2Kgs 4:8-12a, 14-16).
A beautiful act of hospitality is rewarded by God.

Second Reading: (Rom 6:3-4.8-11).
Through baptism we are united to the death and resurrection of Christ.

Gospel: (Mt 10:37-42).
This stresses the sacrifices involved in being missionaries of Jesus and the greatness of even the smallest act of hospitality offered to those missionaries.

CREATING SPACE FOR GOD AND OTHERS IN OUR LIVES

2 Kings 4.8-12a, 14-16; Psalms 89.1-2, 15-16, 17-18 (R.1a); Romans 6.3-4, 8-11; Matthew 10.37-42

We are in God's house to pray, to listen to His Word and to share the one Body and the one Cup. In this dwelling place of God and there shall be no strangers amidst us. As members of the worshipping community everyone should feel welcome and at home. As God accepts us all as we are, we should be hospitable and extend a warm welcome to everyone.

The first reading today tells us how the act of hospitality of the woman of Shunem to Elisha was well rewarded (2 Kings. 4.8-16). Hospitality and welcoming are the very heart of the Gospel. "Whoever welcomes you welcomes me, and whoever welcomes me welcomes the one who sent me..." (Mt.10. 40). Welcoming and hospitality are acts of giving and service to others. Once we generously extend such human acts of acceptance to all especially to the "little ones", the least of our communities, we do it unto Christ, our Lord and God (Mt.25.40). We are compelled to do it as we belong to Christ and live in Christ through our baptism (Rom.6.3-11).

Christ calls us to reach out to others even with small and simple acts of welcoming. The "cup of cold water" is a symbol of small kind of deeds. Although it may not look much, such acts can bring peace, fulfilment, contentment, and a sense of belongingness provided they have a quality, the quality of warmth - the warmth of heart. It is not how much we do that matters, but how much love we put into it.

The "cup of cold water" today shall be a letter, a phone-call, a text message, a smile, a word of appreciation, a warm welcome, a kind visit, an invitation, and a gesture of hospitality. They cost little but can make a difference in the life of people living in certain situations. There are cries for such cups of cold water today in our communities.

To be welcoming and hospitable also means making a space for God and others in our lives. The woman of Shunem created space for Elisha and helped him fulfilling the mission God had entrusted to him. The Word of God today calls on us to make space in us for Christ who comes to us in many forms and appearances.

During the festivity of Canada Day, we remember the Immaculate Heart of the Blessed Virgin Mary. She made a space in her heart for the Word just as she made a space in her womb for His body. She pondered His words in her heart so that gradually her whole life was filled with His presence. She lived a life pleasing to God and positively responded to the needs of people. Mary, our Lady of Perpetual Help, pray for us. Mary, our Lady of Canada, pray for us.
